I have reviewed your request with our Town Planner, Mark Kluge who I have copied to this email.

Upon review, a fence variance will be needed in order to bring the fence farther than 2 meters from the rear wall of the home.

I have attached a lot development plan of your property. The plan indicates that your property line is 4.83 meters from the side wall of the home. That being said, your fence must remain on your property and can be no wider than the 4.83 meters. In addition, the town must be able to access the easement on the north / east corner of the property. When the fence is built, there must be either a gate or removable panels so the town can access the easement as needed.

A complete drawing of the dimensions of the fence must also be provided for review.

There will be a fence variance fee of \$200 and the request will be reviewed by council at the next available council meeting. The \$200 fee can be paid on the phone via credit card or you can attend town hall to complete the payment.
