Re: Leeson Street Traffic Calming Pilot

The traffic calming pilot project along Leeson Street, between Mill Street and Melody Lane, was the first of its kind for the Town to address resident speeding concerns. In mid-August Town staff installed speed cushions, bollards and signage in three locations along this stretch of road with removal of the devices in November 2024.

The final stage of this traffic calming pilot project is to collect resident feedback through a survey.

The survey is accessible online via a QR code (below) or by using the questions printed on the back of this letter.

The survey will remain open until **December 31st, 2024**. Paper copies can be dropped off at the Town Office, 5 Main Street North, in the drop-box.
