Community Centre Expansion	2023-06-15 2023-09-11	Dec. 2025	 The Community Centre addition project is progressing. The contract was awarded to Gen-Pro Construction. Construction has begun and is moving along the projected timeline. As of the writing of this report, soil has been removed, rebar is onsite, and footings are scheduled to be poured this week. Financing agreement between the municipalities is being negotiated.
Concession 2/3 Ball Diamonds Outbuildings			Design work is underway.
Concession 2/3 Ball Diamond Lighting			 Lighting installation commenced in the last week of October and has now been completed. The project has reached substantial completion. Final testing and training have yet to be scheduled.
Concession 2/3 Ball Diamond First Pitch - Grand Opening		May 12th or May 26 th	 Weather/ dry field permitting, "First Pitch" Grand Opening on the First Monday of the new Grand Valley Co-Ed Slow-Pitch League (May 12th). Most players from this league are from the Town. Local sponsors for all the teams and Grand Valley Minor Ball is on the other diamond. Invitation to all Minor Ball Teams to attend as well. Rain/wet field date is May 26, 2025
Hereward Ball Diamond	2024-09-35		Diamond decommissioning has been added to the 2025 Spring Parks workplan.
Grand Valley Trail System			We have started our trail inspections and are almost able to drive from one end to the other. There are still some deep snow-covered areas at the western end of the trail.
